



## Central Dauphin Band Boosters' Association

Meeting Minutes – Tuesday, February 2, 2010

President Eric Bloom called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. The Treasurer's report (Jolene Yaede) was not presented because Jolene had a family emergency. The report will be posted online in the next week or so. The Financial Secretary's report (Tim Clouser) was not finalized because the Treasurer's report was not completed. The Recording Secretary's Report (Sue Douma) was reviewed and passed on the motions of Kay Mesaros and Dr. Mark Guise.

**Vice President's Report (Diane Baker)** - Diane had nothing to report.

**Mr. Ceresini's Report** – Mr. C thanked everyone for coming out in the cold weather. County Band Auditions were held on January 20<sup>th</sup>. Forty students auditioned and thirty students were selected. The students enjoyed getting ready for the audition. Two students auditioned for District Jazz tryouts on January 22<sup>nd</sup>. Both of them made it. This is the third year that these students have made District Jazz. The Indoor groups have turned the corner and it is now competition time. The Parent Preview Show was held January 28<sup>th</sup>. The show was fabulous. Approximately 200 people attended the show. This past Saturday the Majorettes had a show in Biglersville and the Drumline and Guard had a show in Salisbury, PA. Jazz I went to Elizabethtown to play for a senior citizens group. There was a Course Selection Night. There are no new classes, everything remains the same. Contact Mr. C if you have any scheduling problems. Upcoming events: The Winter Concert is February 23<sup>rd</sup>. All groups are playing. The rehearsal for the concert is February 18<sup>th</sup>. The Valentine's Dance is February 10<sup>th</sup>. The Food classes are making the desserts. The dance will be over by 8:30. There will be no swing dance instructions as Dancing Dave has moved out of the area. Joshua Davis, Jazz Studies at Susquehanna University, will have a residency with the Jazz students. The students have a two hour delay on February 11<sup>th</sup>. Indoor Groups have competitions from now until early May. Mr. Ceresini gave us an update on the new uniforms. Stanbury has provided Mr. C with a sample uniform. However, the District has no money for uniforms. Mr. C and East High's band director will be meeting with the Superintendent about the uniforms. Mr. C is not optimistic about getting new uniforms for next year. He said that we are now in a "wait and see" mode. Band Award Applications are due April 30<sup>th</sup>. Practices for the Disney10 trip will be held on: Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup> from 7-9pm, Tuesday March, 2<sup>nd</sup> from 7-9pm, Wednesday, March 24<sup>th</sup> from 3-4:40, and Monday, March 29<sup>th</sup> from 3-4:30pm. An all traveler meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup>. Parents may come to this meeting. President of the Band, Brandon Allen then gave us his report. He said that the Jazz bands played for seniors at Elizabethtown. Brandon said they played quietly because the room was small. He said they received many comments. The concert bands are getting ready for their concert. Next week there will be a Band Officer Meeting. Brandon gave us an update on the Indoor groups. He said that the Majorettes took 1<sup>st</sup> place in their division at the Biglersville show. The Drumline took 1<sup>st</sup> place in their division at the Salisbury, PA show. The Guard took 5<sup>th</sup> place in their division at the same show. Brandon said that the Pit for the musical is going well. He said that have now gotten through the entire book. Then it was time for Vice-President, Ben Guise's report. He spoke about his experience of participating in the US Army All American Marching Band. Ben said this was the best week of his life. He got to meet people from all over the country. He said there was a world class staff. The band practiced at the Alamo stadium and played at halftime for the US Army All American Bowl Game. He also showed us pictures of his experience. Mr. C said that he has nominated

Meagan Kinneer, Christine Saul, Ashley Blaha, and Alex Nguyen to try out for this band next year.

**Scrip – Barbie Bloom.** Disney Scrip (2% discount) is now available in \$25 and \$100 amounts. The Disney Scrip can be used at the Disney gifts shops, restaurants and resorts. Don't forget that you can now get 5% on gas at the Giant stores at both ends of the District (West Hanover/Susquehanna New Giant). We are getting close to ½ million in Scrip sales. January sales totaled \$12,295/Total profit was \$575 (Boosters - \$422; Students - \$153). Fiscal Year To Date sales totaled \$118,856/Total profit was \$5,919 (Boosters - \$4,240; Students - \$1,679). Program totals are \$449,237/Total profit was \$23,572 (Boosters - \$16,802; Students - \$6,770).

**Winter Strawberry Sale – Melissa Graeff** – The sale was cancelled because we could not reach the minimum order. The company agreed to lower the minimum to 100 flats but even with an email blast we were only able to sell 31 flats so the sale was cancelled.

**Coffee Sale – January/February 2010) – Leona Asper** – This product sale is Mr. G Coffee from Lewistown. We sold 65 bags at a cost of \$7.50 per bag. Student accounts were credited with \$153/Boosters with \$65. Delivery will be made to Eric on Wednesday and he will distribute them on Thursday.

**Valentine's Dinner Dance - February 10, 2010 – Michelle Doyle and Cheryl Blaha.** This event will be from 6-8:30pm. Everything is lined up. Cheryl checked with Mrs. Sunday about the desserts. Anyone willing to help should report to the cafeteria at 2:30.

**Craft Show – April 10, 2010 – Judy Koontz** – The show is sold out! We will have 175 crafters and we sold 282 spaces. Judy was more selective this year and we do have a waiting list. Our next big push is for publicity to attract shoppers and for volunteers to help with the show. Volunteer event heads are: Signs- Jeff Imboden (Jeff had signs at the show. He said we could take them and put them out the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of March); Advertising – Melissa Graeff; Volunteers – Joanne Baylor; Show Setup – Rogers Koontz; and Concessions – Jolene Yaede. A request was sent out for folks to remake the wooden signs we place at other CDS schools.

**Indoor-RAM-a – April 17, 2010 – Sue Acri, Sue Douma, Sue Kinneer, Barbie Bloom and Michelle Doyle.** Thirty-two groups have committed so far. Program advertising handouts will be distributed to the indoor kids this week. There is a 70/30 Booster/Student Split. There are also one-line ads. Please don't solicit businesses that are already our sponsors. Cindy Case has volunteered to do the Indoor program.

**Band Banquet – May 21, 2009 – Donna Skelton and Sally Davies.** There is a committee meeting on February 11<sup>th</sup>. Seniors should fill out the online questionnaire located on the CD website on the band's page. Seniors should also submit a baby/child picture and a current picture.
