

Directions to Central Dauphin High School

From the north or east:

Follow I- 81 South to the Manada Hill exit 77. Turn right off the exit onto Rt. 39 West and proceed 2 miles to the traffic light at Piketown Rd. Turn left onto Piketown Rd. and left into the school.

From the south or west:

Follow I-81 North to the Linglestown Exit 72B . Turn right off the exit onto Mountain Rd. Proceed to the flagpole in Linglestown square and turn right onto Rt. 39 East; continue for 1.5 miles to the traffic light at Piketown Rd. Turn right onto Piketown Rd. and left into the school.

****Or**** follow I-81 North to Manada Hill Exit 77. Turn left onto Rt. 39 West and proceed 2 miles to traffic light at Piketown Rd. Turn left onto Piketown Rd. and left into the school.

Spring Craft Show Guidelines and Policies

About Our Show

The Spring Craft Show is held indoors in the new, modern, well-lit, & air-conditioned Central Dauphin High School. Admission and parking are free. The show includes nearly 200 crafters, concessions, and a raffle throughout the day. Ample free parking is available for all. The school is located just off Route 39 in Harrisburg, PA with easy access from Interstates 81 and 83.

Merchandise

Because handcrafted items are our emphasis, the Spring Craft Show traditionally draws many shoppers looking for specially-made, unique items. To ensure our reputation for top quality, handcrafted items, although we are not a juried show, we nevertheless reserve the right to refuse crafter assignments for anyone offering commercially made or franchised items. We do not allow animals, fish or burning of candles, incense or potpourri at the Spring Craft Show.

Crafter Spaces

We appreciate our returning crafters! We give priority to crafters from last year's Spring Craft Show who submit timely applications. We then carefully review new applications and assign crafters to the space most appropriate for the merchandise you offer and your space requirements. We will consider special requests for placement. When possible, we will honor location and size preferences. Your selection of preference does not guarantee placement, however.

Show Fees

The fee for each 8' x 6' space is \$40. You MUST keep your displays within the space you rent. Please bring your own tables, chairs & extension cords.

Setup & Breakdown

Setup begins at 6:00 a.m. Volunteers will be available to assist in unloading your vehicle. After unloading, please move all vehicles to the assigned vendor parking area. Do not mount, tape, or nail anything on walls. Show is from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. **Break down time begins at 3:00 p.m. No exceptions to this rule; we will not invite back crafters who disregard this rule.**

Concessions

We'll serve food and drink all day from the school cafeteria. Your crafter confirmation packet will include details concerning the opportunity for crafters to order lunch and have it delivered to your space. We offer free coffee all day to each crafter!

Deadlines

Application deadlines:

January 8, 2010 for returning crafters and January 22, 2010 for new crafters. We'll mail notice of acceptance by early February. If the show's full by the time we receive your check, and you don't want to join the show's waiting list, we'll return your check.
