cafeteria for space, could do premium spaces; paperwork goes out end of August/September; yard signs to be put up sooner; same lay out, same charge for next year and possibly a way for them to pay online

Banquet – Sandy McClain – Colonial golf and Tennis Club June 1 at 6 pm; buffet; dessert donations; Historian will put together a picture slideshow; parents can send in pictures; financial assistance available if needed and can contact Mr. Tate and Mr. Bitner for that; \$25 a person and Band Boosters will cover the cost for directors and attending staff; gifts being ordered
